

York And District Beekeepers Association (YDBKA) Membership

The membership year is 1st October to 30th September. For most membership categories, membership of the York & District Beekeepers Association (YDBKA) automatically includes membership of the Yorkshire Beekeepers Association (YBKA) and the British Beekeepers Association (BBKA).

Membership Categories

FULL MEMBER: Annual subscription provides the full range of benefits of membership – including membership of BBKA and YBKA; entitled to vote at all meetings of same; insured for 3rd party liability; receive newsletters from BBKA, YBKA and ourselves ("Combings" is our quarterly in-house magazine)

PARTNER MEMBER: Must live at same address as Full member. Receives same benefits with the exception of "Combings"

JUNIOR MEMBER: Category is for anyone under 18 years of age – same benefits as Full Member. Insurance is via a nominated Parent/Guardian. If Parent/Guardian is a Full Member, then Junior should apply as a Social member

SOCIAL MEMBER: Registered with YDBKA only. Entitled to vote at YDBKA meetings and receives "Combings"

By becoming a member, you agree to the following:



Gift Aid

The Gift Aid scheme allows YDBKA (being Registered Charity number 1177037) to recover tax paid on a gift from HM Customs & Revenue (HMRC). THERE IS NO FURTHER COST TO YOU. We make an annual application to HMRC and they pay the refund to us by bank transfer. This is a significant extra income for us, at very little effort beyond completing the appropriate HMRC paperwork, so we hope that all those who are eligible will sign up to the scheme. Please note that subscriptions paid for another person (such as a birthday gift) or those paid for by a business or other 3rd party are not eligible for the Gift Aid scheme. Subscriptions paid out of a joint account by one party will be eligible for all other joint account holders if they agree to the declaration.

By agreeing to Gift Aid, you declare that for all gifts of money you make today, and in the future, as Gift Aid donations, you will pay income tax and/or capital gains tax that is at least equal to the amount that the Charity will reclaim on my gift for each tax year – 6th April one year to 5th April the next year. You should notify the Charity in writing if you want to cancel this declaration, change your address, or no longer pay sufficient tax on your income or capital gains.
